

EMERITUS STATUS FOR BOARD MEMBERS

The Monterey County Office of Education is grateful for the past service and numerous contributions of its Board Members who are leaving the office and recognizes their potential as a continuing valuable resource, and is committed to fostering an ongoing relationship with them. They are encouraged to engage in service to the Monterey County Office of Education in whatever ways are found to be satisfying and mutually beneficial.

To be eligible for consideration for Emeritus status, a Board Member must have served on the County Board of Education for twelve years, with other significant service as a school district trustee or in combination with service in the field of education.

The County Board President shall appoint a Nominating Committee, consisting of two Board Members who are not being considered and the County Superintendent, to consider candidates for Emeritus status. The Nominating Committee will convene whenever the names of qualified candidates are recommended to the Board for Emeritus status.
