

STUDENT AND FAMILY PRIVACY RIGHTS

The Monterey County Board of Education respects the rights of Monterey County Office of Education (MCOE) students and their parents/guardians with regard to the privacy of their personal beliefs and the confidentiality of their personal information. The Monterey County Superintendent of Schools or designee is expected to develop Administrative Regulations to ensure compliance with law (20 USC 1232h) when the MCOE requests, retains, discloses, or otherwise uses the personal information of its students and their families
