WHEREAS, California Education Code 37222.10(a) designates the second Wednesday in May as **California Day of the Teacher**, a special observance that honors the teaching profession and the dedicated professionals entrusted with fulfilling the mission of education to prepare students for a successful future; and

WHEREAS, the teaching profession touches individuals with great and lasting effects from early childhood to adulthood and plays a fundamental role in guiding, supporting, and preparing students to live, work, and succeed in a highly connected world; and

WHEREAS, the Monterey County Board of Education recognizes that the quality of all students' educational experiences depends significantly and vitally upon the quality and dedication of their teachers, and is proud of the many exemplary teachers in Monterey County who provide daily inspiration and guidance to their students; and

WHEREAS, the success of over 75,000 students in Monterey County depends on the skills, knowledge, positive influence, encouragement, and attitudes of dedicated teachers who work collaboratively with school board members, superintendents, administration, colleagues, parents, families and others in support of society's commitment to quality education for all youth; and

WHEREAS, **California Day of the Teacher** is sponsored by the California Teachers Association, the Parent Teacher Association, the California Federation of Teachers, the Association of California School Administrators, the California School Boards Association, the California Association of School Business Officials, and School Services of California; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Monterey County Board of Education does hereby adopt Resolution of Commendation Number 16-17-39 to recognize the numerous contributions and nurturing guidance of our local teachers and recognizes May 10, 2017 as **California Day of the Teacher**; and, moreover, urges parents, students, and the community to show their appreciation for all Monterey County teachers.
