Welcome to our MCOE South County Special Education Programs. My name is Allison M. Steinmann, and I have been serving as your principal with MCOE since August 2015.

I have served students with special needs for 17 years. As a teacher, I have worked with many students who have diverse special needs. I have developed Community Based Learning and Community Job Learning programs. I believe as an education professional we serve the students, families and community by advocating and supporting all students. I have dedicated myself to ensure all students receive the highest level of education and life skill development.

Our South County Special Education Programs include these King City sites: Gabilan School with four classrooms; two classrooms on the Santa Lucia School campus (1st - 5th grades); one classroom on the Del Rey Elementary School campus (1st - 5th grades); and one classroom on the Chalone Peaks campus (6th-8th grades). We also have the MCOE ECE/Preschool classroom and the MCOE Therapeutic Intervention Classroom at Greenfield High School, and our classroom at Rose Ferrero School for students in the 1st - 3rd grades.
