

RESIGNATION

Monterey County Board of Education (County Board) members who wish to resign shall file a written resignation with the Monterey County Superintendent of Schools. County Board members shall also give a copy of the written resignation to the County Board President.

The resignation shall become effective when filed, except when a deferred effective date is specified in the resignation. A board member may not defer the effective date of his/her resignation for more than sixty (60) days after filing. A written resignation, whether specifying a deferred effective date or otherwise, shall be irrevocable once filed.

A board member who tenders his/her resignation with a deferred effective date shall, until the effective date of the resignation, continue to exercise all the powers of the office, except those involving the provisional appointment of his/her successor.
