

JUVENILE COURT SCHOOLS

As required by law the County Board of Education shall provide for the administration and operation of Juvenile Court School Classes in any Juvenile Home, Day Center, Juvenile Ranch or Juvenile Camp established in accordance with the law.

It shall be the policy of the Board to have the County Superintendent of Schools establish, administer and operate Juvenile Court Schools.

The County Superintendent in establishing, administering shall:

1. Cooperate with other County agencies as needed to operate the educational program.
2. Hire adequate staff for the educational program.
3. Develop and carry out a Course of Study that has been adopted by the County Board of Education.
4. Carry out any additional requirements that may arise in the proper operation of Juvenile Court Schools.
