## **EVALUATION / SUPERVISION**

The Monterey County Superintendent of Schools (County Superintendent) designates the Assistant Superintendent of Human Resources to be responsible for the development and administration of uniform procedures for a systematic periodic evaluation of all certificated and classified employees in accordance with the California Education Code and negotiated contracts. Evaluations serve to hold staff accountable for their performance.

The evaluation for each certificated employee shall be made on a continuing basis. Evaluations shall recognize the exemplary skills and accomplishments of employees and to identify areas needing improvement. When areas needing improvement are identified, it is the responsibility of employees to perform satisfactorily, fulfill their duties, and improve their performance. Reasonable support shall be provided by the Monterey County Office of Education to assist employees in improving their performance and may require participation in appropriate programs. Employees are encouraged to take the initiative necessary to promote effective improvements.
